

Discussion Questions & Prayer for Family Worship  
Week of June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020



Scripture Passage: **James 2:14-19**

\*Note: The Kids' and Students' questions start with an "engaging question," and they transition into the "heart-level truth" we're aiming at. It ends up as more of a "talk" than a simple Q & A. That's why they look long 😊

Discussion Questions for **KIDS**:

- 1) Main Idea: **WE SHOW OUR LOVE FOR GOD BY LOVING OTHERS** – When was the last time someone told you they loved you? Did you believe them? Why? *God says that we show that we love HIM by the way we care for OTHERS.*
- 2) Main Idea: **GOD WANTS US TO LOOK OUT FOR THE WEAK** – Have you ever been "picked on" by someone older or bigger than you? Did you enjoy that? Do you ever do that sort of thing yourself? *God calls those who trust in Jesus to take care of the weak rather than take advantage of them.*

Discussion Questions for **STUDENTS**:

- 1) When was the last time someone you went to for help said something like "good luck with that"? What good is it to say to a hungry, poorly clothed person, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled"? *What tends to motivate you to go beyond mere words and good feelings when it comes to serving others?*
- 2) What is a quality that you look for in a friend? How much patience would you tend to have with someone who only talked as if they were a good friend, without ever actually coming through in the end? *Do you think you're more likely to err on the side of workless faith or faithless work in relation to God?*
